Purpose of Contest: Above all else, Boone Hall Plantation and Boone Hall Farms wants The Miss Berry Princess Contest to be a fun and enjoyable experience for the little girls, their families, and visitors to the Lowcountry Strawberry Festival. It is designed to do just that. Each contestant will receive a participation recognition prize package awarded on stage regardless of the outcome of the competition.

Contest Rules:

- Entry is for the first 30 girls entered, 4-8 years of age . However, Boone Hall Plantation reserves the right to make exceptions to the above age stated for participation. Entry fee is \$25.00. Most of this will be used to buy the prize packages and awards for the competition. All contestants must have turned in an entry form and entry fee by Friday April 9, 2010. But call us if this is an issue for you & we will see if we can work something out.
- The contestants are requested to wear some sort of strawberry outfit for the competition. However, we don't want this to be a hardship or a reason for not participating. This part of the contest is designed to add to the fun and color of The Lowcountry Strawberry Festival and the Miss Berry Princess Contest. As an alternative, contestants will be allowed to wear whatever they choose, as long as the outfit is appropriate and in good taste.
- The judges will determine the winner of the contest and the judges' decision will be final.
- All contestants are requested to be dressed and present at the entrance to the festival By 12:30pm on the day of the competition. A representative from the competition will be on hand at the entrance with a list of the contestants. The accompanying parent or guardian and contestant will then be directed to the staging area for the competition and given further instruction.
- Admission for the contestant and one accompanying parent or guardian to The Lowcountry Strawberry Festival is included in the entry fee. This is important. Any other family members or friends must pay admission before entrance to the festival or the competition. No exceptions. Admission is \$5 for adults and children under 12 are \$3.
- As part of the competition, each contestant's name will be called and the contestant will walk across the stage...stand briefly in front of the judges...and then walk off the stage. We will have people stationed stage side to help the girls on and off the stage. It is preferred that they walk unassisted across the stage. However, if a child gets confused or has difficulty crossing the stage, she will be assisted to do so. We prefer parents and guardians stay in the audience seating area...but if a little girl gets upset and needs help from Mommy or Daddy...then that parent or guardian will be allowed to help their child at their discretion. Again, we want this to be fun for everybody.

The Winner of the Miss Berry Princess Contest will:

- *Receive a beautiful crown and that will be hers as she will be Miss Berry Princess 2010.
- *Receive An Exciting Prize Package
- *Represent Boone Hall Plantation and The Lowcountry Strawberry Festival at some personal appearances, parades, and public events. Some local travel may be required, but the Winner's participation at these functions will be solely left up to her parent or guardian.
