**There Is NO Special-Event Entry for the Boone Hall Pumpkin Patch at Boone Hall Plantation's Main Gate on Long Point Road.**

The Boone Hall Pumpkin Patch is located 1/2 mile north of Long Point Rd. in Mt. Pleasant, S.C. If using a map guidance program for directions on your mobile device, please enter 2434 N. Hwy. 17, Mt. Pleasant, S.C. 29464 as the destination. Guests attending the Boone Hall Pumpkin Patch should be aware that this special event is ticketed independently of regular tours and admission to Boone Hall Plantation.

The *Family Friendly Halloween Tractor Tour* is great fun for kids and kids at heart. Along this mile and a half journey through the woods, guests will experience fun special effects, bright colors, spooky skeletons and fun Halloween-themed displays. This daytime experience is fun for all ages and is experienced comfortably and safely from our tandem axle wagons pulled by real John Deere tractors.

This daytime attraction is not connected to or operated in conjunction with The Last Ride Haunted Hayride which is part of our nighttime attraction, Boone Hall Fright Nights. ### 10. Is There a Corn Maze?

Yes! We're excited to present the 2024 Luke Bryan-Starling Chevrolet Corn Maze endorsed by this huge country music star as well is a tribute to our presenting sponsor whose partnership and support we are very fortunate to have for many of our special events. This year's maze includes a massive 7-acre main maze as well as a smaller, 1-acre mini-maze for the less adventurous.

### 11. Does Paid Admission to the Boone Hall Pumpkin Patch Include Admission to Boone Hall Plantation?

No. The Boone Hall Pumpkin Patch is a separately ticketed Special Event which takes place at Boone Hall Farms. Admission to the festival does not include admission to tour Boone Hall Plantation and daily tour tickets for Boone Hall Plantation do not include admission to the festival. *Please Ensure You Purchase the Correct Special Event Ticket for the Boone Hall Pumpkin Patch when Purchasing Online Tickets.*

### 12. Can I Bring My Pet?

For the safety of your pet and our staff and guests, we must ask that pets be left at home. Only ADA-Compliant service animals are permitted at our special events in accordance with Boone Hall Farms' Service Animal Policy.

### 13. What is Boone Hall Farms Service Animal Policy?

Service Animals are defined as dogs that are individually trained to do work or perform tasks for people with disabilities. This may also include miniature horses. No other animals qualify and will not be permitted.

With respect to legitimate service animals, Boone Hall Farms will strictly adhere to the following, in conjunction with the ADA and the State of South Carolina Attorney General's guidance:

- Any animal whose task is to provide protection, emotional support, well-being, comfort, or companionship is not considered a service animal and WILL NOT be allowed on the grounds.
- All service animals must remain by the handler's side at all times and must be harnessed, leashed, or tethered; unless these devices interfere with the service animal's work or the individual's disability prevents using these devices. In that case, the individual must maintain control of the animal through voice, signal, or other effective methods.
- If the animal, at any time during their presence on the grounds, is not housetrained or acts up to include barking, biting, walking around or jumping on other patrons, the Charleston County Sheriff's office will direct the removal of the animal.
- In compliance with DHEC regulations, service animals are not allowed in the petting zoo, produce stand/tent, or in our U-Pick fields.

Please note that these policies are in effect for ALL Boone Hall Farms Special Events and should not be confused with Boone Hall Plantation's pet policy for guests touring the Plantation and Gardens.

### 15. It's Raining Where I'm At, Is the Event Open? Can I Get a Refund?

The Boone Hall Pumpkin Patch is designated as a Rain or Shine event. Sustained heavy rainfall, high winds, lightning, or other conditions which prohibit the safe operation of the event may result in delays or closures. Shows and attractions will remain open unless inclement weather presents a safety concern. In the event of a temporary closure due to weather, attractions will reopen as soon as our safety team determines it is safe to resume operations.

There are NO REFUNDS or rain checks on tickets purchased for the 2024 Boone Hall Pumpkin Patch.

### 16. Can I Smoke or Vape?

For the health and safety of all guests and in the interest of fire safety on our Farm, The Boone Hall Pumpkin Patch is a tobacco-free event. Select designated smoking areas are identified inside the grounds by signage. Our No Smoking Policy includes the use of smokeless tobacco products as well as electronic cigarettes and vapes of all sizes.

### 17. Do You Offer Military Discounts?

Boone Hall Farms is pleased to offer a \$3 admission discount to active duty or retired military with ID. A valid military ID must be presented at the time of purchase and is only valid for purchases made on-site at the event. Military discounts may not be combined with any other promotion, discount, or offer.

### 18. Do You Have a Lost & Found?

Yes! Items recovered or turned in at the event will be held at the main admission gate (near our roadside produce stand) until the end of the event. Items which have not been claimed will be held in our safe for a period of 7 days following the conclusion of the event after which time they will be donated or discarded.

### 19. Are There Restrooms?

Yes! Portable restroom facilities with hand sanitizer are located throughout the event grounds on both the family farm side and the midway. Handwash stations are also strategically positioned throughout the grounds for your health, safety, and convenience.

### 20. What Items are Prohibited at this Event?

Laser Pointers, Pocket Knives, Tasers/Stun Guns, Mace/Pepper Spray, Weapons of Any Kind (Including Off-Duty Law Enforcement and Guests with Concealed Weapons Permits), Alcohol, Recreational Drugs and Controlled Substances, Outside Food or Drink, Pets (Except Licensed Service Animals), Cameras with Detachable Lenses, Drones, and any other items as determined by Boone Hall Farms' Management.
